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Director's Notes

It feels like a very long time since I was last writing director's notes for a production at Whitchurch High School, with the significant national events of the past two years making their impact known. Thankfully, however, the show must go on, and through the past two years the arts sector has fought to return, and this is no less of an understatement with the Music and Drama departments here in Whitchurch High School. It is a great pleasure to be writing director's notes once more, but even more so because of what it represents; the return to the stage for the Whitchurch High School Upper School Production.

Sister Act is a divine musical comedy and a sparkling tribute to the universal power of friendship, sisterhood and music based on the hit 1992 film of the same name. It tells the hilarious story of the disco diva Deloris Van Cartier ('as in Cartier') whose life takes a surprising turn when she witnesses a murder. Under protective custody she is hidden in the one place she won't be found – a convent! Rehearsing for any Upper School production is extremely rewarding and valuable, but this musical has taken on new significance for all involved as we have navigated the ever-changing field of restrictions, whilst whole-heartedly relishing being able to be back doing what we love. I am constantly wowed by the dedication of all the pupils involved, from our extremely capable principal leads who are taking on such significant responsibility with the sheer number of musical routines to say the least, to our hard-working and reliable ensemble, always keen to step up to any role asked of them. Not to mention the back-stage crew who have been so eager to get back into the process too – they traditionally have to wait the longest until their 'call time' and the number of emails and requests to start attending have been noticeably increased this year! This is yet another production carried by a hard-working family of young actors, singers and crew who have dedicated themselves and given freely of their time to create the production you are about to watch.
